



## Associate Degree Nursing LPN to ADN Program Getting Started Checklist

We are committed to helping you achieve your goals! Follow the steps on this guide to apply for the Associate Degree Nursing LPN to ADN Program. A review of your academic performance and the following requirements are utilized to score your admission placement in the program.

This program offers courses in a full time option. See program website for additional information, locations, and option details. This program admits new students on the Lincoln and Beatrice campuses:

- **LPN to ADN (Lincoln): Every Spring Semester**  
Spring Semester: Apply September 1<sup>st</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>
- **LPN to ADN (Beatrice): Spring semester of even numbered years**  
Spring Semester: Apply September 1<sup>st</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>

### Program Acceptance:

Applications will be reviewed when ALL requirements are submitted AND pre-requisite courses are completed. The program utilizes a selection process of all complete applications to determine acceptance into the program. Applications with incomplete or missing requirements at the time of selection will not be reviewed. The application for the program will remain open until the end of the application period and/or until the program spots are filled. Please note the following:

- Applicants with courses in progress will not be reviewed for acceptance until the end of the term AND after the submission of all requirements.
- Applicants **MUST** resubmit all documentation during each application period.

### Getting Started:

#### Are you currently an SCC student enrolled in classes at SCC?

For students currently enrolled in a program at SCC and/or working on pre-requisite courses for a Health Sciences program please meet with your assigned College Advisor. If this is your first term at SCC you will be connected with your advisor after completing *New Student Enrollment*. #### Are you new to SCC or unsure where to start?

### Demonstrate Appropriate Level of Proficiency in Reading and/or Math:

- Must have completed MATH 1100 or higher or place into MATH 1150 or higher
- Proficiency can be demonstrated with placement test scores OR course completion. For details related to placement testing or to schedule a placement test go to <https://www.southeast.edu/nextgenerationaccuplacer/>.

### Complete Program Pre-Requisite Requirements: Students must receive a grade point average of 2.75 for the sciences (Anatomy, Physiology, Nutrition & Chemistry) and 2.5 for the general education courses for admission into the program. Submit official transcripts showing college coursework completed at a college/university other than SCC, to SCC Admissions Office 8800 O Street Lincoln, NE 68520.

Students are eligible to apply for the program when ALL pre-requisite courses are completed. See college catalog for specific course requirements.

- Human Anatomy with Lab
- Human Physiology with Lab
- Chemistry with Lab
- Communication Studies
- Written Communications
- Nutrition for the Healthcare Provider (HLTH1100)

These courses may be taken prior to or while enrolled in the LPN to ADN program.

- Intro to Sociology or Diversity in Society
- Pathophysiology through the Lifespan (HLTH1070)



- Complete Program Professional Awareness Activity:** HESI LPN to ADN Mobility Exam (submit documentation). See program website for instructions and forms to submit. **Only emailed or printed results will be accepted.**
  
  - Complete Program Application:** Apply at <https://www.southeast.edu/applynow/> during the stated application periods. For students interesting in starting:  
Spring Semester: Please apply September 1<sup>st</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>.
    - First review of completed applications will begin on October 15<sup>th</sup>; the application will remain open until all program seats are full.
    - Notification of acceptance will occur **after** November 15<sup>th</sup>.Incomplete applications will not be reviewed if missing program requirements.
  
  - Complete Clinical Requirements:** Submit the following during the application period. Submit documentation to the Health Sciences Building (HSB 230) or email: [healthsciences@southeast.edu](mailto:healthsciences@southeast.edu).
    - Active unencumbered Nebraska LPN license **or Active unencumbered Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC) state LPN/LVN license** (submit DHHS proof of license)
    - HESI LPN to ADN Mobility Exam: Printed or emailed results; information found on program website
    - Proof of current CPR for Basic Life Support (BLS) Healthcare Providers American Heart Association **only**
    - Complete Student Health Statement (see documentation form on program website)
